



Standing Committees

Each committee has a responsibility for the growth and success of the Indiana Affordable Housing Council. These committees are driven by their individual committee charters which outline scope and key objectives as well as ways to measure their own success.

These committees will conduct business of the Committee through an ongoing schedule of quarterly conference calls and/or electronic communications, or otherwise as scheduled by the Chair. Committee members are expected to devote sufficient time to participate in and contribute to the Committee activities. Committee members are required to adhere to the Committee Charter and assume and complete assignments as designated.

Government Affairs: Tasked with reviewing and proposing legislative agenda items and keeping IAHC membership apprised of legislative issues affecting the affordable housing industry. Working closely with contract lobby personnel and association management staff, this committee also provides the vision behind all legislative events and meetings.

- **Committee Makeup:** President (Chair) and at least three additional committee members appointed by the board of directors.
- **Subcommittee: IHEDA Policy (Formerly QAP Committee)** – discusses policy as it relates to the Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority. Proposes potential changes and collects feedback to serve as one voice on housing policy.

Nominating Committee: Responsible for recruiting, vetting and proposing board members and council officers, the nominating committee is the gatekeeper of the board of directors. The committee also conducts the member election process at both the annual meeting and board of director's officer elections.

- **Committee Makeup:** Secretary (Chair) and at least three additional committee members appointed by the Board of Directors.

Finance Committee: Provides financial oversight for the organization. The committee drafts the proposed annual budget and oversees all financial planning, financial reporting and the creation and monitoring of internal controls and accountability policies.

- **Committee Makeup:** Treasurer (Chair) and at least three additional committee members appointed by the Board of Directors.



Membership Committee: Consider strategies, promotions and required budgets needed to enhance membership growth. Collaboration with other committees, this committee sets key strategies to increase membership recruitment, engagement, and retention.

- **Committee Makeup:** Vice President (Chair) and at least three additional committee members appointed by the Board of Directors.
- **Subcommittee: Events** - Assists in the development and execution of IAHC events, including but not limited to the annual Indiana Housing Conference, and IAHC Legislative Reception.

Executive Committee: A smaller group with close ties through leadership who can get together, often with little notice, to address pressing issues that affect the organization substantially, such as an emerging crisis. The executive committee has the power to act on behalf of the full board.

- **Committee Makeup:** President (serves as Chair), Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Chairperson Emeritus* (if applicable)
 - *There is only a Chairperson Emeritus if after an Elected Officer's term as President is over and this person remains on the Board of Directors.
